This multi-day virtual workshop will help SUNY faculty and advising staff address the challenges of scaling mathematics pathways at their institutions. The overall outcome of the virtual workshop is for campus teams to create an action plan to ensure all students are well-served by the institution's mathematics pathways. The workshop is designed to promote discussion and learning within and across teams on a number of topics, including collaboration between mathematics and advising departments, approaches and techniques associated with advising for mathematics pathways, and how to communicate mathematics pathways information.

Who should attend: All SUNY-SSTF colleges and universities are invited to send a team of 4 to 6 representatives. At minimum, this team should include:

- One mathematics faculty member familiar with the mathematics pathways and corequisite support work.
- Academic advising director or coordinator.
- At least 2 professional academic advisors and/or faculty advisors and/or student affairs staff member with advising responsibilities
